

Field Team Selection 2007

Archers wishing to be considered for the Great Britain Field Team for 2007 will be required to finish a minimum of three, two-day FITA 24 shoots in the period between the end of the 2006 All British Championship and the end of the 2007 All British Championship.

Only the scores from completed two-day tournaments will be considered. All record status combined or mixed tournaments within Great Britain and Northern Ireland may be included. In addition, the selectors will consider up to two scores from tournaments outside Great Britain and Northern Ireland, provided that these are shot at two day FITA 24 Arrowhead Status events. All Rounds must comply with the FITA Rule Book, Book 1, Article 4.5.3.7 for the Unmarked and Article 4.5.3.8 for the Marked Round.

For tournaments outside Great Britain and Northern Ireland, it is the responsibility of the individual archer to supply an official result sheet to the selectors.

In the period from the end of the 2006 All British Championship to 31st December 2006, a maximum of one score at any venue will be considered by the selectors. In the period from 1st January 2007, up to and including the 2007 All British Championship, a minimum of two and a maximum of three scores will be considered by the selectors. Subject to these restrictions, selection will be decided by comparison of each archer's best three scores during the selection year. Archers with the highest aggregate scores may be offered team places.

Scores will only be considered twice from the same venue if the shoots are in different selection periods, i.e. the scores from Pentref's Spring Shoot could be used in conjunction with the scores from the autumn Welsh Championship (also at Pentref). The score from the 2007 All British Championship may be used, irrespective of venue.

The minimum qualifying standard for each bow division and category has been determined as a score equaling the average 16th place score from the qualifying rounds at the 2003 and 2005 EFAC's and the 2004 WFAC.

To be eligible for selection, three two-day scores must equal or exceed the minimum qualifying standard.

In the event of there being tied aggregate scores, the selectors will look at each archer's two highest scores in the period from 1st January 2007 up to and including the 2007 All British Championship and select the archer with the higher aggregate of those two scores.

In the event of no archer reaching the qualifying standard in a particular discipline, the selectors may recommend the inclusion of the highest placed archer in that discipline in order to ensure team representation.
