<p><b>Championship Competition Format/s</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individual</li> </ul> <p><b>Maximum 4 places as follows:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 Women recurve</li> <li>• 1 Men Recurve</li> <li>• 1 Women Barebow</li> </ul>						
<p><b>General Points of Eligibility</b></p>	<p>Archers are eligible for consideration provided they are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An Archery GB member in good standing</li> <li>• Have satisfied all eligibility under the rules of World Archery (WA) and subject to any changes it may introduce subsequent to the publication of this policy</li> <li>• Available for selection of the stated event</li> <li>• Hold a current full UK passport, valid for at least 6 months after return date of the event</li> <li>• Have met the required selection scores (see below)</li> </ul>						
<p><b>Milestone Event Performance Target/s</b></p>	<p>1 medal</p>						
<p><b>Context and Purpose of Championship selection</b></p>	<p>To be considered for selection for the 2017 World Games, all athletes must provide evidence of the following World Class scores achieved at verified national or international competitions. <p><b>Timetable</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12<sup>th</sup> June 2016 to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2017: Selection Score Window</li> </ul>						

<p><b>Selection</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Field Committee will make the selection of the athletes for the Performance Director to sign off.</li> <li>• Selection will be the leading competitive international performers on score from 3 x 2 day combined or combination rounds in the last 12 months between the All British Field Champs 2016 and the end of the All British Field Champs 2017. (Preference may be shown towards an athlete who has submitted a score(s) in the 2017 season.)</li> <li>• The selectors will consider whether archers are internationally competitive and have the potential to deliver medals.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Nomination and Selection Panel</b></p>	<p>Following the completion of the designated selection process listed in this policy, the Performance Director will consult with Events and Facilities Manger and the Field Committee, support staff, appropriate Performance staff and an independent observer, and take into account any relevant input deemed necessary to discuss the nomination of the athletes, before confirming selection to the Team.</p>
<p><b>The ‘Team’</b></p>	<p>The ‘Team’ means the team which is selected by Archery GB which includes athletes, coaches, nominated reserves, medical support personnel, team leaders and any associated members of the World Class Programme team.</p>
<p><b>Appeals</b></p>	<p>Appeals against process must be submitted to the Performance Office by the end of office hours on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2017. Appeals will be conducted according to the details on the Archery GB website.</p>
<p><b>Following the conclusion of the selection process.</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Once athletes and other Team members have been advised of their selection by the Performance Director, they (including any reserve(s)) must agree not to withhold any information on availability, fitness, injury status or illness that could affect their training or competitiveness at any time until the conclusion of the event;</li> <li>2. All selected athletes must declare any medications they are taking, in particular the use of any restricted medications and that they hold a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) which can be produced when required by the relevant authority;</li> <li>3. An athlete and other Team members will be required to sign up to the relevant Code of Conduct or Athlete Agreement and any breach of this may result in disciplinary action including removal from the team and possible early return home from an event. In this case, any member sent home will be invoiced for the full cost of their entry into the event and any additional cost incurred in sending them home. Decisions on these matters are open to appeal as allowed by the relevant Archery GB Disciplinary process effective at the time of the incident.</li> <li>4. Athletes and other Team members selected, are required to attend all related training camps and competitions as laid out by the Performance Director and Events &amp; Facilities Manager, from the selection announcement onwards.</li> </ol>

	5. Athletes and other Team members will be expected to demonstrate they can actively contribute to the team unity required to be a successful international team.
<b>Announcement</b>	Selected team members must agree not to make any announcement to the media or public in any form (including on any social or other media) regarding their selection until after Archery GB have announced the selection on the Archery GB web site <a href="http://www.archerygb.org">www.archerygb.org</a>
<b>Any matters not covered by this Policy</b>	Any matters arising from the selection processes, which are not covered within this policy, shall be determined by the Performance Director (or representative thereof) acting at their sole discretion.
