<b>General Points of Eligibility</b>	<p>Archers are eligible for consideration provided they are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An Archery GB member in good standing</li> <li>• Have satisfied all eligibility under the rules of World Archery (WA) and subject to any changes it may introduce subsequent to the publication of this policy</li> <li>• Available for selection of the stated event</li> <li>• Hold a current full UK passport, valid for at least 6 months after return date of the event</li> <li>• Have no medical or wellbeing conditions that preclude travel by air to defined venue</li> <li>• Have met the required selection scores (see below)</li> </ul>										
<b>Milestone Event Performance Target/s</b>	<p>3 medals</p>										
<b>Context and Purpose of Championship selection</b>	<p>Selection is made in line with competitive performance standards in the international arena. AGB will only select athletes who can demonstrate they can be competitive and/or contribute to our objectives of medal winning success and as such the selection scores are based on previous achievements at International tournaments of similar standing to this event The Performance Director, will consider only athletes deemed to be competitive at this level, and may elect to take fewer than the maximum permitted athletes.</p>										
<b>Timetable</b>	<p>1<sup>st</sup> July 2017 through to 30 June 2018: Selection Window</p>										
<b>Selection</b>	<p>Archers wishing to be considered for the UK 3D Field Team for 2018 will be required to complete a minimum of One, two-day 3D shoot in the period between 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 and 30th June 2018, the UK Team for the European Field 3D Archery Championships will be selected within 2 weeks of this end date. Only the scores from completed two-day tournaments will be considered.</p> <p>In addition to Nominated tournaments within the United Kingdom, the selectors will consider a maximum of One score from tournaments outside Great Britain and Northern Ireland, provided that these are shot at two day WA 3D Status events. For tournaments outside the United Kingdom, it is the responsibility of the individual archer to supply an official result sheet to the selectors. Scores shot outside the United Kingdom after 30<sup>th</sup></p>										

	<p>June 2018 will not be considered for selection.</p> <p>Scores from major 3D international championships, e.g. World Championships, will be accepted without proof of individual archer's scores and classed as equivalent to a score from a 'Nominated Course'. Archers gaining individual medals in the previous year's major international championships will automatically be considered for selection in 2018, provided they remain active field archers.</p> <p>To be considered for selection for this event, all athletes must provide evidence of the following World Class scores achieved at verified national or international competitions.</p> <p>A single / two score(s) of:</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="400 577 1062 680"> <thead> <tr> <th></th> <th>Barebow</th> <th>Compound</th> <th>Instinctive</th> <th>Longbow</th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td>Men</td> <td>786</td> <td>915</td> <td>675</td> <td>620</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Women</td> <td>630</td> <td>760</td> <td>520</td> <td>410</td> </tr> </tbody> </table> <p>In the event that no archers reach the qualifying standard in a particular discipline or division, the selectors may offer a place to the highest placed archer in that discipline in order to ensure team representation. <p><b>Nominated Courses</b></p>	<p>The Nominated events for the 3D selection in 2018 are:</p> <p>9<sup>th</sup> &amp; 10<sup>th</sup> June at run by Eagle Bowmen and hosted by Avalon Archers in Sandy, Bedfordshire</p> <p>23<sup>rd</sup> &amp; 24<sup>th</sup> June at Banbridge in Northern Ireland</p>															
<p><b>Nomination and Selection Panel</b></p>	<p>Following the completion of the designated selection process listed in this policy, the Performance Director will consult with the Field Archery Advisory Group, support staff, appropriate Performance staff and an independent observer, and take into account any relevant input deemed necessary to discuss the nomination of the athletes, before confirming selection to the Team.</p>															
<p><b>The 'Team'</b></p>	<p>The 'Team' means the team which is selected by Archery GB which includes athletes, coaches, nominated reserves, medical support personnel, team leaders and any associated members of the World Class Programme team.</p>															
<p><b>Appeals</b></p>	<p>Appeals against process must be submitted to the Performance Office within 14 days of selection being published. Appeals will be conducted according to the details on the Archery GB website.</p>															
<p><b>Following the conclusion of the selection process.</b></p>	<p>Once athletes and other Team members have been advised of their selection by the Performance Director, they (including any reserve(s)) must agree not to withhold any information on availability, fitness, injury status or illness that could affect their training or competitiveness at any time until the conclusion of the event;</p> <p>All selected athletes must declare any medications they are taking, in particular the use of any restricted medications and that they hold a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) which can be produced when required by the relevant authority;</p> <p>An athlete and other Team members will be required to sign up to the relevant Code of Conduct or Athlete Agreement and any breach of this may result in disciplinary action including removal from the team and possible early return home from an event. In this case, any member sent home will be invoiced for the full cost of their entry into the event</p>															

	<p>and any additional cost incurred in sending them home. Please note that the consumption of Alcohol or the use of controlled Drugs at any time during the event is prohibited and considered gross misconduct.</p> <p>Decisions on these matters are open to appeal as allowed by the relevant Archery GB Disciplinary process effective at the time of the incident.</p> <p>Athletes and other Team members selected, are required to attend all related training camps and competitions as laid out by the Performance Director and Events &amp; Facilities Manager, from the selection announcement onwards.</p> <p>Athletes and other Team members will be expected to demonstrate they can actively contribute to the team unity required to be a successful international team.</p>																		
<p><b>Funding Criteria</b></p>	<p><b>Team Management</b></p> <p>Wherever possible the team management that are supporting the event will be funded by ArcheryGB.</p> <p><b>Funding Model</b></p> <p>The default method of funding Archers participating in ArcheryGB nominated international events is one of a self-funding model with a potential of receiving a rebate based on the performance achieved at the event.</p> <p>In exceptional circumstances, Archers that are restricted from attending due to financial hardship and can provide evidence through previous medal achievements can request funding in advance when supported by appropriate evidence. Example of evidence would be proof of previous medal achievements in the appropriate discipline together with suitable documents identifying income and financial status.</p> <p>Residual funds will be made available to partially offset the costs incurred by the competing archers with the award based on the performance level achieved at the event. Therefore any funds will be provided after the event has completed and therefore each representative will need to initially source funds for attendance at the event. 	<p>Bronze 10%</p> <p><b>Competitors in the event</b></p> <p>If 16 or greater competitors participate in the archers category then 100% of allocated value can be awarded if below 16 then the percentage multiplier is based on actual competitors divided by 16</p> <p>e.g 8 competitors give a 50% multiplier</p> <p><b>Funding amount</b></p> <p>Maximum Archer funding is set at a maximum of the expected cost to participate.</p> <p><b>Total Funds limits</b></p> <p>Where awarded amounts potentially exceed the budget available then the awarded amount calculation will be amended to limit the awards to keep within the budgeted amount</p> <p><b>Funding Calculation</b></p> <p>The total amount awarded after the event uses a calculation based on the above criteria, as an example a person achieving a Bronze Medal in an event with 8 competitors will receive 40% of the maximum archer funding plus any award due for a Team medal, assuming that the total awards do not exceed the overall budget allocation</p> <p>Example;</p> <p>Bronze X 8 Participants X maximum award + Team Silver X Maximum award</p> <p>80% X 50% + 20% = 60% of maximum award</p>
<p><b>Team Events</b></p>	<p>Where Team competitions are scheduled into the event, the selection of the competitors in the relevant team event such as Men’s Team, Women’s Team will usually consist of 1 archer from each competing style (Compound, Longbow and either Barebow or Instinctive) 3 in total.</p> <p>The selection of the competitors is made from the results from the qualification rounds.</p>
<p><b>Announcement</b></p>	<p>Selected team members must agree not to make any announcement to the media or public in any form (including on any social or other media) regarding their selection until after Archery GB have announced the selection on the Archery GB web site <a href="http://www.archerygb.org">www.archerygb.org</a></p>
<p><b>Any matters not covered by this Policy</b></p>	<p>Any matters arising from the selection processes, which are not covered within this policy, shall be determined by the Performance Director (or representative thereof) acting at their sole discretion.</p>
